Classroom Requirements

Part 1 - Minimum Hardware Requirements

- Pentium 4 - 1.4GHz or higher
- 2 GB RAM minimum, 4 GB recommended.
- 10 GB free hard disk space (preferably in C: drive).
- Network connectivity to the internet. Note: Some of the lab exercises require functioning Internet access.

Part 2 - Minimum Software Requirements

- Windows Server 2000 SP4, Windows Server 2003 Standard Edition or Enterprise Edition. (Other versions of Windows are not supported)
- Adobe Acrobat Reader 6.0 (can be downloaded at <http://www.adobe.com>)
- Winzip (can be downloaded at <http://www.winzip.com>)
- Internet browser (Firefox, Internet Explorer, etc)
- Note. This class will be using the following pieces of software: DB2 Enterprise 8.2, Tivoli Directory Server 6.0, WebSphere Portal Server 6.0. No pre-setup for these components will be required as they will be installed during class exercises.

Part 3 - Software Provided

You will receive two USB memory sticks containing the following files:

- WA1511_1.ZIP
- WA1511_2.ZIP

All other software listed under Minimum Software Requirements is either commercially licensed software that you must provide or software that is freely available off the Internet.

Part 4 - Important Ghosting or Imaging Information

The software for this course can be ghosted.

Software Installation

Part 1 - Preparation

__1. Create a user called **wasadmin** with password **wasadmin** and grant this user administrative access.

__2. Restart the computer and log in as **wasadmin**.

__3. From the first USB memory stick, extract the **WA1511_1.ZIP** file to C:\

__4. From the second USB memory stick, extract the **WA1511_2.ZIP** file to C:\

__5. Review that the following folders were created:

- C:\LabFiles
- C:\Software\W-1
- C:\Software\W-2
- C:\Software\W-3
- C:\Software\W-4
- C:\Software\W-5
- C:\Software\W-6
- C:\Software\W-7
- C:\Software\W-8
- C:\Software\W-Setup

NOTE: You don't have to install any piece of software. The students will be installing the software as part of their labs.
