

To install Tomcat 4.1.18

- ___ 1. Download the zip file from www.webagesolutions.com/download/jakarta-tomcat-4.1.18.zip using the username and password access.
- ___ 2. Unzip the file into C:\. This will create a new subdirectory named **jakarta-tomcat-4.1.18**.
- ___ 3. From the Control Panel, select **System**, the **Advanced** tab and then **Environment Variables**. Add the following new environment variable to point to the root directory of your Tomcat hierarchy:

 Variable Name: CATALINA_HOME
 Variable Value: <drive>\jakarta-tomcat-4.1.18

 Make sure you do not place a \ after tomcat.
- ___ 4. Add the following new environment variable, **JAVA_HOME**, to point to the root directory of your JDK hierarchy:

 Variable Name: JAVA_HOME
 Variable Value: <drive>\jdk1.4.1_02
- ___ 5. Set the environment variable, **CLASSPATH**, to point to the root directory of your class files you will create. I.e., set it to:

 <drive>\Jakarta-tomcat-4.1.18 \common\lib\servlet.jar;
- ___ 6. Start Tomcat using the <CatalinaHome>\bin\startup command. Open a Command Prompt window, change the directory prompt to

 <drive>\jakarta-tomcat-4.1.18\bin>

 and enter

 startup
- ___ 7. Open a web browser, such as Internet Explorer or Netscape Navigator, and go to **http://localhost:8080**. You should see a web page with the Tomcat logo at the top.

Stop Tomcat using the <CatalinaHome >\bin\shutdown command.
