Part 1 - Minimum Hardware Requirements

- CPU to meet the minimum requirements of the operating system being used
- 3 GB RAM minimum, 4 GB recommended
- 15 GB in the hard disk
- USB port

Part 2 - Minimum Software Requirements

- One of the following Windows versions:
 - Windows Vista (Business, Enterprise, or Ultimate)
 - Windows 7 (Professional, Enterprise, or Ultimate)
 - Windows Server 2008
 - Windows 8
- Adobe Acrobat Reader
- Zip extraction utility
- VMware Player

* - indicates software provided as part of the courseware.

Part 3 - Software Provided

You will receive the following file:

- **WA2060.ZIP**

All other software listed under Minimum Software Requirements is either commercially licensed software that you must provide or software that is freely available off the Internet.

Part 4 - Important Ghosting or Imaging Information

The software for this course can be ghosted.

Part 5 - Instructions

- __1. Extract the **.ZIP** file to C:\
- __2. Review that the following folder was created:
 - **C:\VM_WA2060**

Part 6 - Installing VMware Player

__1. Open a file browser and find the VMware player executable file located in C:\VM_##### folder where ##### is the code for this course. [Example: C:\VM_WA2060]

Note. If you don't find the VMware player executable file in this folder then download it from the VMware website using the following link:

- __2. Run the VMware player executable file and accept all the defaults during the installation.
- __3. Restart the computer.

Installation verification of VMware Player

- __1. Start VMware Player.
- __2. If prompted to download a new version of VMware player decline the update.
- __3. Click Open and select the file located under the C:\VM_##### folder where ##### is the code for this course. [Example: C:\VM_WA2060]
- __4. When prompted indicate that you "moved" the virtual machine.
- __5. Start the virtual machine and verify it works fine. If you are running a CentOS image use **root** as user and **centOS** as password.

__6. If asks to install the tools do it.

__7. Shut down the virtual machine.

__8. Any Antivirus, AntiSpyware and software similar should be disable during the class. The performance of the VMWare image will be affected if an antivirus is running during the class.

__9. Optional – Add a desktop shortcut to the '.vmx' file in the folder with the image files. Having a shortcut to this file on the desktop will make it easier for students to launch the image.
