Part 1 - Minimum Requirements to host the VMs

- 64-bit x86 CPU that supports hardware virtualization (Intel-VT or AMD-V)
- Hardware virtualization enabled in the BIOS
- Windows 8.1 or similar
- 2 cores
- 8 GB RAM, 12 GB recommended
- 80 GB Hard Disk
- VMWare player or workstation 15

Part 2 - Software

__1. You need the following Software:

- **VM-WA3098-REL-1-1**

__2. The software will be provided by email and contain many zip files.

__3. Once you get the zip files, extract the 01 zip file in your hard disk, it will extract all the files from all the zips.

__4. Open the folder where the zip was extracted.

__5. Right click on the *.vmx file and select **Send to** → **Desktop (create a shortcut)** to create a shortcut in the desktop and then rename the shortcut as:

- **VM-WA3098-REL-1-1**

Make sure to rename the shortcut because this name is used during the labs.

__6. Using the shortcut in the desktop, start the VM.

__7. Login using **wasadmin/wasadmin** as credentials.

__8. Open the version file in the desktop and verify version is:

- **VM-WA3098-REL-1-1**

__9. Close the VM.
